From Vice Chancellor's Desk

EXPLORING A BLENDED LEARNING ECOSYSTEM IN THE ACADEMIC ENVIRONMENT

Education is a prerequisite and key for the evolution of an innovative ecosystem. E-learning approaches are applied both in educational institutes and in an entrepreneurial environment. Modernizing the agricultural education system, in line with the National Education Policy, emphasizes the need to use digital resources and tools to make teaching and learning in agriculture more effective and easy to access.

A statement in the Delhi declaration, ICAR states that the science, technology, engineering, agriculture, and math (STEAM) policies in higher education for agriculture should be changed and multi disciplinary education should be encouraged by technology. According to NEP-2020, digital education and blended learning (BL) with face-to-face in-person learning is needed to combine the dual advantage of an online educational system with physical place-based classroom teaching methods.

Agricultural education cannot be entirely online. Students have to work in labs and visit fields and villages. Practical and project-based assignments cannot be dispensed with online learning. Blended learning will not skip these essentials, but it will complement experiential learning through virtual and augmented reality labs, virtual classrooms and engaging videos.

Several changes have been incorporated in common academic regulations relating to credit load requirements and their distribution and the system of examination and internship during the under graduates programme and provision has been made for Ph.D Scholars to enrol for online courses and take advantage of e-resources through e-learning and teaching assistant-ship.

Blended learning mode may provide the opportunity for learners to utilize the resource materials uploaded on different online platforms (Agri-DIKSHA and e-Krishi Shiksha portal). This also enables the faculty to overcome resource constraints to provide high-quality and relevant agricultural education of required standards.

Blended learning mode is being used nation-wide to help learners to develop skills along with the effective learning and skill development traits related to the subject-domains.

TRANSFER OF TECHNOLOGY

OFT- Control of Black Thrips& Management practices in Chillies

Krishi Vigyan Kendra (SKLTSU), Ramagiri khilla, Peddapalli district has conducted OFT on "Management practices of Black Thrips in Chilli" in KVK adopted village Seethampet, Muttaram Mandal on 16.11.2022. As per SKLTSU recommendations, Fipronil granule s@5kgs per acre and Blue Sticky traps @ 25 per acre has been distributed to the chilli farmers. After one month of visit KVK has distributed Formula 4, Fipronil+ Lamda (spray) and neem oil to the same farmers and found that 70 to 80 percent of Black Thrips was under control.
