







Essay Writing, Elocution & Making of G20 Logo Competitions for Students of State Universities as part of creating awareness on India's Presidency of G20

The Hon'ble Governor and Chancellor desired to hold competitions in 3 categories namely 1. Essay 2. Elocution and 3. Making of G20 logo for State University students as part of raising awareness among university students about India's G20 presidency and providing a platform for university students to project their innovative, exciting, novel ideas and imaginative skills on India's role as G20 President. The Hon'ble Governor will distribute the prizes to the winners, and all the participants will be given participation certificates.

The first and second contests i.e., 1. Essay 2. Elocution will be in four languages, i.e., 1. Telugu, 2. Hindi, 3. English, and 4. Urdu, and the topic of i) Essay and ii) Elocution will be:

"One Earth, One Family, One Future (Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam) —the vision of India's G20 Presidency"

Depending on the demand and student availability, the universities may decide to restrict the number of languages offered.

The third competition will involve **creating the G20 logo** in any form, such as sculpture, painting, or any other mode. The JNAFAU will be the sole organiser of this competition, and the University will invite nominations from students from all state universities in Telangana.

These contests will be conducted at two levels.

Primary level will be conducted at each intra University level and the final level which is conducted at inter University is Final level.

Preliminary level: The universities will give wide publicity and invite names for participation for the contests in the given format, and they will conduct the contests and finalise the best five contestants in each category, like "essay in English," "essay in Telugu," "essay in Hindi," "essay in Urdu," etc., and so on and send their names and details to Raj Bhavan.

Final level: The Raj Bhavan, in collaboration with TSCHE, will hold a state-level competition for contestants who emerged as winners in the preliminary level, as communicated by the vice chancellors, and basing on the performance in final level, the first, second, and third prizes and the three consolation prize winners in each category will be determined.

The aims of **Competitions** are:

- To project their ideas on India's role as President in leading G20.
- provide an excellent platform to bring out the creativity, innovation
 & imagination among the university students;
- To provide a competitive environment across university students to present their skills, views and ideas;
- To enrich the writing skills and thought provoking speeches in the fertile minds of young people;
- To create awareness on the subject and also to improve their skills in recreation in sculpting / painting / moulding / making.

Guidelines:

- a. All students of State Universities in Telangana are eligible to participate.
- b. The essays / elocution can be written in four languages i.e., English / Hindi / Telugu / Urdu languages.
- c. They should write their essays / attend elocution at the given venue on the date and time intimated to their mobiles by way of SMS.
- d. The length of essay should not be more than 3000 words and time for elocution will be 3 minutes.
- e. The papers will be evaluated based on their novelty of contribution, originality of thought, and the ability to stimulate interest by the eminent professors. The elocution will be evaluated based on the oratory skills and subject knowledge and creative futuristic ideas.
- f. They should submit their names with their respective universities for first level i.e., preliminary level. Top five winners of each category will be participating in the second level i.e., final level.

- i. The date, time and venue of essay writing competition for the second level students will be intimated through SMS to them.
- j. The date, time and venue of elocution competition will be intimated through SMS to the registered mobile numbers.
- k. The G20 logo's made by students shall be submitted to JNAFAU for evaluation and Jawaharlal Nehru Architecture and Fine Arts University will send to Raj Bhavan for exhibition.
- I. The State level winners will be intimated through SMS about the prize ceremony to be conducted at Raj Bhavan through SMS.
- m. All participants at State level in all categories will be given participation certificates.
